

To obtain your NCCER Number follow these steps.

Go to this website. <https://www.nccer.org/nccer-number/>

Select Create NCCER Number

This will take you to the NCCER Number Request Form, where you will enter the following information,

Name, E-mail Address, Birthday, Alt ID Type and Number, Place of Birth and Mobile Phone. For the Alternate ID it may show Social Security Number or another option. If you do not wish to use your Social Security Number, there are many other options.

To obtain an NCCER Number you can use your Florida or other state's Driver's License number. Florida High School students can use their Florida SNIF (Student Number Identifier Florida). Click on the down arrow and find the Alt ID you wish to use.

When you have completed all the information click on the I agree box and click I am not a Robot. Finally, click on the Search Box.

You should receive a quick response in your e-mail with your NCCER Number and authenticating your account. If not in your in-box check your junk or spam folder. You should at this point be able to set up your password for your account and complete your Profile.

Record your number, this along with your password that will be used going forward for access to your NCCER records. You will need this number and your last name during the Module Testing Sessions for your NCCER Credentials.
